\$1.50 Pizza Sticks w/sauce (2) – Jr. & Sr. High **(Elementary may buy on Fridays)**

\$1.50 Mozzarella Sticks (5) – **Includes choice of one sauce:** Ranch Dressing, Pizza Sauce or Cheese Sauce **(25¢ for each extra sauce)**

LUNCH EXPRESS GUIDELINES

High School & Junior High (Grades 7-12):

Lunch must be ordered by 9:30 a.m. However, nachos and cheese and the salad bar are available to those students who did not order the lunch of the day. Also available are snack items that may be purchased for lunch. If a lunch or a la carte item is ordered and is not picked up by the student who ordered them, the student is still charged for those items. If a student leaves school due to a doctor's appointment, etc. at lunch time and has ordered a lunch for the day, the student will be charged for the lunch. However, if a student becomes ill and cannot eat lunch, he/she will not be charged for that lunch.

Lunch express should not be used as a charge account. When a lunch express account is negative \$25, the balance will be transferred to the tuition account with a \$5 late charge and will be subject to the same \$25 late fee per month as is tuition.

A statement will be sent home with the student on Friday when their lunch express account is \$10 or less.

Elementary (Grades 1-6):

Lunch must be ordered by 9:30 a.m. Elementary students are permitted to purchase snack items if they have brought a lunch from home, or have ordered the lunch of the day. On Fridays, elementary students are permitted to either order a lunch or purchase a pretzel, pizza sticks, or breadsticks. If a student is late for school, they must call the school office before 9:30 a.m. and the receptionist will call the kitchen to let them know the student is ordering a lunch. If a child should leave school due to a doctor's appointment, etc. at lunch time and has ordered a lunch for the day, the child will be charged for the lunch. However, if a child becomes ill and cannot eat lunch, he/she will not be charged for that lunch.
