Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest in Middletown Christian Schools.

Middletown Christian Schools has a rich history of providing a well-rounded education for children and youth since 1972 and is committed to assist Christian families in fulfilling their biblical responsibility to educate their children in the light of God's Word. A complete elementary and secondary curriculum, accredited by the Ohio Department of Education, provides excellence in academics through a Christian perspective. MCS seeks to provide students with a solid foundation upon which they can develop their abilities, build successful and productive lives and make a positive difference in their world. Year-round daycare and preschool programs are also available.

Please complete the attached **application and family survey** and return them with the appropriate application fee to the school. All application paperwork is available to be downloaded from or done online at our website, www.mcseagles.net. Remember, all applications received by April 5, 2010, will be eligible for the reduced "early" registration fee. Also, the school needs a **copy of your child's birth certificate** and **most recent report card**. The **Pastoral Questionnaire** needs to be given to the pastor of your church; he will then mail it directly to us. **If** your child has taken the Stanford Achievement test or any other achievement test, during the year, please send a **copy of those results**. **If** your child is in grades 7-12, it is required that they fill out the student survey. **If** your child has been on an IEP at a past school or diagnosed with a learning disability, we also **need a copy of that information**.

After ALL of the above items and fees are received, you will be contacted for an admissions interview and new student testing, if deemed necessary. Student application files must be complete prior to written acceptance. All applications are processed according to the date all paperwork and payment is received by MCS. There is a possibility of classes being filled and applicants having to be put on a waiting/standby list. Therefore, prompt application and completion of all paperwork is recommended.

Middletown Christian Schools seeks to hire qualified, caring, certified, Christian teachers for all its classes. Classes that consist of more than one homeroom are divided into homerooms based upon many different factors. These may include boy/girl ratio, teacher recommendation, academic performance, and personality, plus other personal considerations. This process of making class lists is done with great care and prayer by the school administration. *Any requests for a student to be in a particular classroom must be made in writing to the administration prior to May 28, 2010, for the upcoming academic year. Each request must include specific reasons explaining why the parent is making a request. All requests may not be able to be honored.*
