

IMMUNIZATIONS

TO: All parents of Students Enrolling in Middletown Christian Schools

Middletown Christian School follows the State guidelines which require certain immunizations for entrance and attendance to school. A **record** of these immunizations should be presented to the school office when your child is enrolled in school. This record must be presented within **2 weeks** of the first day of school or your child will be **excluded** from school until the immunizations are on file.

The following immunizations are required by State Law for the 2006-2007 school year:

Hepatitis B	(Series of 3) K through 7 th Grade This will be progressive until all students in K through 12 th grade will be required to have a complete Hep. B series according to guidelines set for their age.
MMR (2)	K through 12 th grade
4 DPT/DTAP	1 st through 12 th grade (Kindergarten Only) Needs 5 th DPT/DTAP if 4 th dose was received before age 4.
4 Polio	Kindergarten-Four doses of polio will apply to all students if they received a combination of OPV and IPV. Students who received all OPV or all IPV and received the third dose on or after their fourth birthday, do not need the fourth dose.
3 Polio	1 st through 12 th grade
Varicella	Kindergarten (Students who have had natural chickenpox are not required to have the varicella vaccine. However, a statement from the parent, guardian or physician is necessary to fulfill this requirement.)

You may obtain immunizations from your family doctor or the Maternal-Child Health Center at Middletown Hospital Immunization Clinic, 105 McKnight Drive, on:
